

#### WHEN DO HORSES REPORT?

Horses for Ohio Scarlet and Gray Championships are due in detention six (6) hours prior to their race on Saturday, October 12, and Sunday, October 13

#### STALL ASSIGNMENTS

- •Horses must go to their assigned stall in the detention area.
- •Stall will be assigned by Nicole Hamlet and will be labeled with horses names.
- •Horses shipping in early prior to the race may go to other areas of the backstretch prior to going into their detention stalls.

## EQUIPMENT ALLOWED IN DETENTION

- Race bike
- Jog cart
- Horse cool out blankets.
- Harnesses
- Harness bags (have trainer open upon arrival)
- Feed tub
- Water bucket (Must be empty on arrival)
- Bath bucket (Must be empty on arrival)
- Sponge
- Scraper.

# EQUIPMENT EXAMPLES

















#### FEED & OTHER ITEMS PERMITTED

- Hay
- Straw
- Other bedding materials
- Bags of feed (Bag must be unopened.)
- Filled feed containers must be checked by security on arrival to the detention area.
- Marked containers of items such as alcohol, lotion, baby powder, and mineral oil.

### WHAT IS NOT PERMITTED IN DETENTION?

- Tack trunks
- Unmarked feed or other supplements
- Unmarked containers of any substance

#### WHO IS/IS NOT ALLOWED?

- Personnel that work with each competitor (groom, trainer, assistant trainer) that are assigned by the trainer.
- Lasix Veterinarian
- Emergency Veterinarian
- Blacksmith
