

Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association Future Equine Career Scholarship

- 1. Applicant or family member OHHA membership is preferred, but not required.
- 2. Preference will be given to Ohio residents.
- 3. Completed application, essays and all supporting documentation must be received in the OHHA office (whether by fax, email, or mail no later than December 1. Late applications will not be accepted.
- 4. One letter of recommendation is required and should be from a connection to the harness-racing industry. A form for completion is attached within, if needed.
- 5. Applications will be accepted from students currently pursuing vocational or academic training in a field related to the equine industry. Applicants must be at least 16 years of age.
- 6. Scholarships are to be used toward the cost and expenses related to the schooling.

 Preference is to pay the school or program coordinator directly or to reimburse for costs associated with the school or program, verification required.
- 7. Presentation of the annual Future Career Scholarship recipient will be made at the OHHA annual meeting. The scholarship recipient will receive three tickets to the scholarships banquet at OHHA expense.
- 8. The Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association reserves the right to alter, amend, and administer this program in their sole and complete discretion.
