Richard served as an Elder for two terms, as chair of the Stewardship Committee and as Building Chairperson for two additions to the church. Finally, he served as Treasurer until December 2007.

He is survived by his children, Leslie and son-in-law Archie Haynes, Mary Elizabeth Wright, and Lori Edwards; 7 grandchildren, 14 great-grandchildren; 4 great-great grandchildren; and many nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Emma Joyce (Minton) Slaughter; a son, Mark Richard Slaughter; and two brothers, John Slaughter Jr., and Dale Slaughter; and two sisters, Phyllis Madan and Sarah Akers.
