Dennis Jon "Denny" Zernhel, 74, of rural Custar, Ohio died Wednesday, February 19, 2025 at Bridge Hospice Care Center, Findlay, Ohio.

He was born September 30, 1950 in Findlay, Ohio to the late John "Jiggs" and Edna (Funk) Zernhel. Denny was a 1968 graduate of McComb High School and received an Associate's Degree from Penta Technical College.
