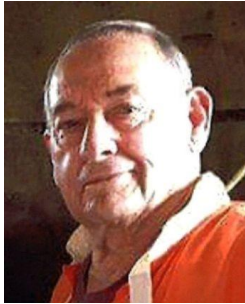


Everett P. Crowe, 93, obituary
