

Double Header Day Highlights from The Great Darke Co. Fair

The Great Darke County Fair's 4-day meet continued Saturday with 10 races in the morning and a 16-race card in the evening.

In the morning session, driver Jeff Nisonger continued his domination with 3 driving wins, but Christopher Hope was hot on his heels in second with 2 driving wins and 1 training win.

The fastest mile of the morning session was race 7 and it went to Just Zip It (4, M by Cheyenne Rei - Roca Suave - Abercrombie) who is conditioned and owned by Chris McGuire and driven to victory by Jeff Nisonger.

In the evening session's fourth race, trotter Homer Hall (3, G by Broadway Hall - Cynthia Iliad - Armbro Iliad) smashed the track record at The Great Darke Co. Fair for 3yo male trotters in 1:58.0h, winning by 14 lengths with driver Ryan Holton for trainer Steve Carter, caretaker David Young II, owners Steve Carter, Jay Mossbarger, and Cass Gallagher and breeder Midland Acres, Inc.

(*Previous record was 1:59.0h set on 8/19/2017 by Magic Vacation for Ryan Miller)

Driver Ryan Holton led the evening card driving colony with 4 wins and Jeff Nisonger finished with 3. In the first three race cards, Jeff Nisonger has garnered a whopping 15 wins to lead all drivers through the midway point of the 4-day race meet.
